### Possible Harmful ingredients

#### Sensitizers

- Natural rubber proteins
- Zinc Diethyldithiocarbamate

### Application - Limitations of use

Hand protection

Poor versus oils, greases, organic solvents and hydrocarbons  
Glove protects from radioactive contamination outside of containment enclosures

Do not use against flames or temperatures < 0 °C or > 100 °C

### Storage

Keep away from sources of ozone or ignition.

Keep out of direct sunlight; store in a cool and dry place.
